

# Crash cart supply & equipment checklist

## Equipment

- Airway (oral and nasal) all sizes
- McGill forceps, large and small
- King Airway set (3) eliminates the need for laryngoscope and endotracheal tubes
- Bag valve mask (adult and pediatric)
- Nasal cannula
- Non-rebreather oxygen face masks (3 sizes)
- IV start packs
- Normal saline solution (1000ml bags)
- IV tubing
- Angiocaths (various sizes)
- 10ml normal saline flush syringes (8–10)
- Gauze
- Alcohol preps
- Monitor with defibrillator (preferred) or AED
- Syringe nasal adaptor (nasal Narcan atomizer)

## Drugs

- Aspirin 81mg tablets (4)
- Nitroglycerin spray or 0.4mg tablets
- Dextrose 50% (Dextrose 25% if treating pediatrics)
- Narcan 1mg/ml (6)
- Epinephrine 1:10,000 pre-filled emergency syringe (5)
- Atropine Sulfate 1mg pre-filled emergency syringe (3)
- Amiodarone 150mg vial (4)
- Epi Pen (2)
- Epi Pen Jr (2)
- Solumedrol 125mg vial
- Benadryl 50mg Vial (2)
- Adenosine 6mg (5)
- Lopressor 10mg (2)
- Lidocaine 100mg/5mL pre-filled emergency syringe (2)
- Cardiazem 20mg vial (2)
- Pronestyl (Procainamide) 1g in 10 ml 100mg/ml vial (1)
